# Advising and Student Success

The Center for Student Success and Retention is aptly named. Simply put, the academic success and thus, the retention of our students is the goal of the Center. Period.

Whatever help a student needs to be successful...we will try to provide. No, we can't write the papers or take the tests... but we can help the student figure out how to do these things better. But its not all just about academics. Creighton University

wants students to thrive in every way - socially, spiritually, emotionally and physically.

The formula is simple:  
**to thrive = to stay = to graduate**

Creighton is proud of its consistently strong retention rate for freshmen. Over the past several years, Creighton has averaged 88% retention. This far exceeds the national retention rate and is also higher than many private universities similar to Creighton.

# Faculty Advisors

Admitted students are assigned a Faculty Preceptor who, as a faculty member, will serve as the academic advisor throughout the first year. At the end of your first year, you will select a pre-major advisor from the department of your intended major, unless you are in the College of Business Administration where your Faculty Preceptor will advise you until you select a major. You will then officially declare a major at the end of sophomore year and be assigned an advisor. Creighton students often tell about how accessible their advisor was to them, helping them schedule classes or find jobs or even just being available for a chat.

# Study Abroad

Each year, Creighton students have the opportunity to spend an academic year, semester, or summer abroad. The Study Abroad Coordinator works closely with each student to select a program that meets his or her educational, professional, and personal needs.

Nearly 250 Creighton University students live and study in other countries all across the globe. Creighton's Study Abroad program can encompass anything from a traditional university in Europe to living with subsistence farmers in the Dominican Republic. In any case, study abroad means learning as much out of the classroom as in it.

# Encuentro Dominicano (Dominican Encounter)

The Encuentro Dominicano (ED) is a semester-long program in the Dominican Republic. Courses are taught by the academic director and other visiting Creighton faculty members. During the semester, students will spend time in a "campo," living with a host family and completing a service project. The program is a mix between the traditional approach to study abroad (living together, studying and traveling) and an immersion component that puts students in direct and prolonged contact with communities that survive on subsistence farming and occasional outside employment.

**Cortina Community** - The Cortina Community is a communal, co-ed, service-learning program for selected sophomore students based on four distinct values: community, service, faith, and justice.

**Freshman Leadership Program (FLP)** - The Freshman Leadership Program (FLP) is a

residential, experiential learning community housed on the ninth floor of Kiewit Hall.

**The Magis Ambassadors** are representatives of the student body that act as liaisons between Creighton University and the Omaha community. Members of this elite organization are model students who are excited to be a student at Creighton University and who truly seek excellence in their lives.

**Emerging Leaders Programs** - The Student Activities Office has a variety of programs for emerging leaders on campus, primarily for sophomores and juniors.

**Leadership Education Grant** - Through a grant from Pepsi, funding may be available for students who are attending conferences that are geared towards leadership development. Students are asked to share what they learn with the greater Creighton Community upon their return. Applications are reviewed bi-weekly.

**Omicron Delta Kappa (ODK)** - Omicron Delta Kappa (ODK), national leadership honor society, annually hosts the Founders Week Leadership Recognition Awards Day to honor the "behind the scenes" leaders in our community.

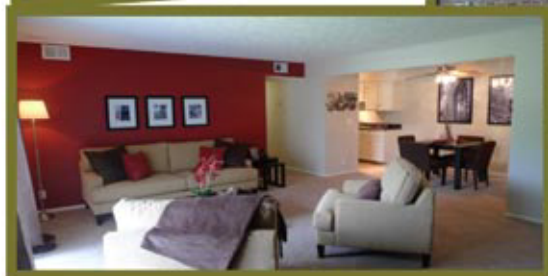
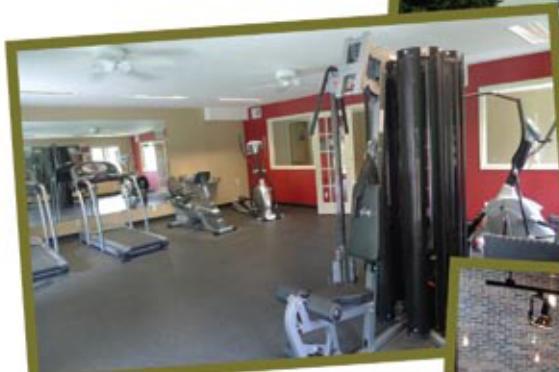
