Welcome from the Executive Vice President

My name is Frank Ayers, and I am very pleased to serve as the Executive Vice President and Chief Academic Officer in charge of the Prescott campus. I joined Embry-Riddle nearly ten years ago, after a long career in the U.S. Air Force, and I actively participate in nearly every part of student life on campus from supporting the flight team to serving on homecoming committees. I take pride in having been deeply involved in developing and nurturing academic programs that make our Embry-Riddle students the envy of the aviation, engineering and public service sectors. I am a 1986 graduate of Embry-Riddle and completed my doctorate in education in 2008. As a fifty-something year-old student, I was doing nightly homework just like every other Embry-Riddle student, so I understand the challenges they face. Your sons and daughters are the reason I come to work every day and I would like to develop a more personal relationship with you as well.

Let me tell you about what your students will be doing this fall. A group of engineering and business students are building and marketing a 300 mph jet dragster (not to worry, we will have a professional driver, Elaine Larsen, behind the wheel). Our nationally recognized "Golden Eagle Flight team" has dominated national competition, winning 7 national championships, and they are getting ready for number 8. Our global studies students will be planning and executing a national conference on global security. Our athletic teams continue to impress us with their competitive spirit, stellar grade point averages, and their sportsmanship. The Air Force and Army ROTC detachments commissioned 44 2nd Lt.s last semester, and have a full slate of leadership activities for this year. Two of our student flight instructors, and grad students, Kristen McTee and Kristine Anthony, flew over 4,000 miles to complete the "Women's Air Classic" Air Race. In a recent NASA competition, 3 sophomore Engineering students placed 7th overall, among 35 prestigious engineering schools

(most made up of Senior level students) and our Lunar All-Terrain Regolith Excavator (LAR-E) robotics team finished fourth, out of 75 teams nationally and won the trophy for "most innovative design".

Let me also tell you what Embry-Riddle is doing for our nation right now. Nicole Stott, (pictured proudly flying the Embry-Riddle colors) is an astronaut and a graduate of Embry-Riddle's Engineering program. She flew on the Space Shuttle last Spring, along with another Embry-Riddle alumnus, Al Drew. Their flight was

supervised by Senior Mission Controller, Norman D. Knight (another Riddle alum). Embry-Riddle graduates dominate the engineering staffs at Boeing, Cessna, and other major manufacturers; Embry-Riddle pilots are the largest and highest quality single group of commercial pilots in the world. They make our skies safer every day. Graduates of our Global Security and Aviation Business programs are taking seats at the Treasury Department, State Department, and in the boardrooms of aviation businesses around the country.

Please do not hesitate to call or e-mail me with your questions, suggestions and concerns. I will always get back to you personally within one day on any issue. Also, please communicate with our deans and department chairs. They can also help you, especially with academic issues. The best part of Embry-Riddle is the close relationship between students, faculty, and parents that starts at the top. I look forward to getting to know you better and meeting you personally at our Parents' & Family Weekend in the spring.

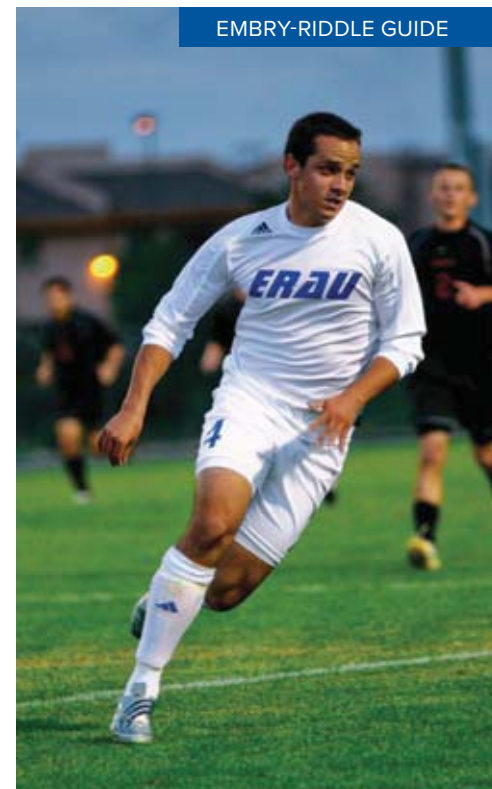
Athletics

Intercollegiate Athletics

The University sponsors six Intercollegiate sport programs at the Prescott Campus: Women's and Men's Golf, Men's Wrestling, Women's and Men's Soccer, and Women's Volleyball. Any student who meets both University and NAIA eligibility requirements is able to compete for a position on a varsity team. Athletic grants-in-aid, in varying amounts, are generally awarded to recruited varsity student-athletes, with walk-on players earning the right to compete for scholarship assistance when available. Intramurals & Recreation

Intramural and recreational sports are available on campus and create an atmosphere of competition and fun by offering a wide variety of activities. Other sports such as sand volleyball, table tennis, racquetball, tennis, ultimate Frisbee and disk golf are offered as small tournament play. Other sports are also available on request. 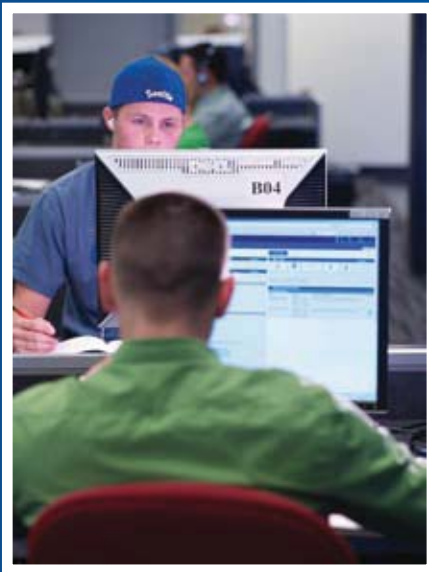

Library

The Hazy Library and Learning Center offers a technologically-rich and aesthetically inviting environment. Students have access to individual study areas, group and collaborative presentation rooms, and more than 80 computers throughout. The library provides onsite collections, access to information and knowledge resources, multimedia technologies and professional staff for assistance. The library is open 102 hours per week during the fall and spring semesters and provides extended hours before final exams.

Student Life

The Department of Student Life provides numerous opportunities for all students. We provide on-campus living for all freshmen, as well as upperclassmen and non-traditional aged students. In addition to providing on-campus living opportunities, Student Life offers a wide variety of student organizations, leadership development workshops and entertainment for the campus community.

Competitive Spirit

In addition to our athletic programs, our students compete for various titles and recognitions nationally. Among them, Phi Beta Lambda, the business club, has consistently swept top honors in the statewide competition. The Underwater Robotics club recently took home a first place honor in the National Underwater Robotics Challenge. The Golden Eagles precision flight team has consistently ranked among the top in the country in the Safety and Flight Evaluation Conference (SAFECON) competitions and has captured the national championship title seven times. Female flight students also have a special opportunity to represent the campus in the Air Race Classic, a transcontinental race for women that dates back to 1929.

Student Government Association (SGA)

The Student Government Association council is elected each year by the student body and responsible for providing a communication link between the students, and the faculty, staff and administration. SGA council members lead a student panel during new student orientation, participate in almost every committee on campus and the president of the SGA is a student delegate to Embry-Riddle's Board of Trustees. The SGA serves as the voice of the students and provides many enhancements to student life through its service organizations: Riddle Radio, Board of Campus Activities (BCA), Horizons Newspaper and Task Force One (TFO) for incoming students. Additional SGA services for students include, but are not limited to: a free beverage service, Safe Ride (a free taxi ride to students who feel they are in an unsafe situation), a student directory, discount cards, lawyer services, lockers and a free fax service.

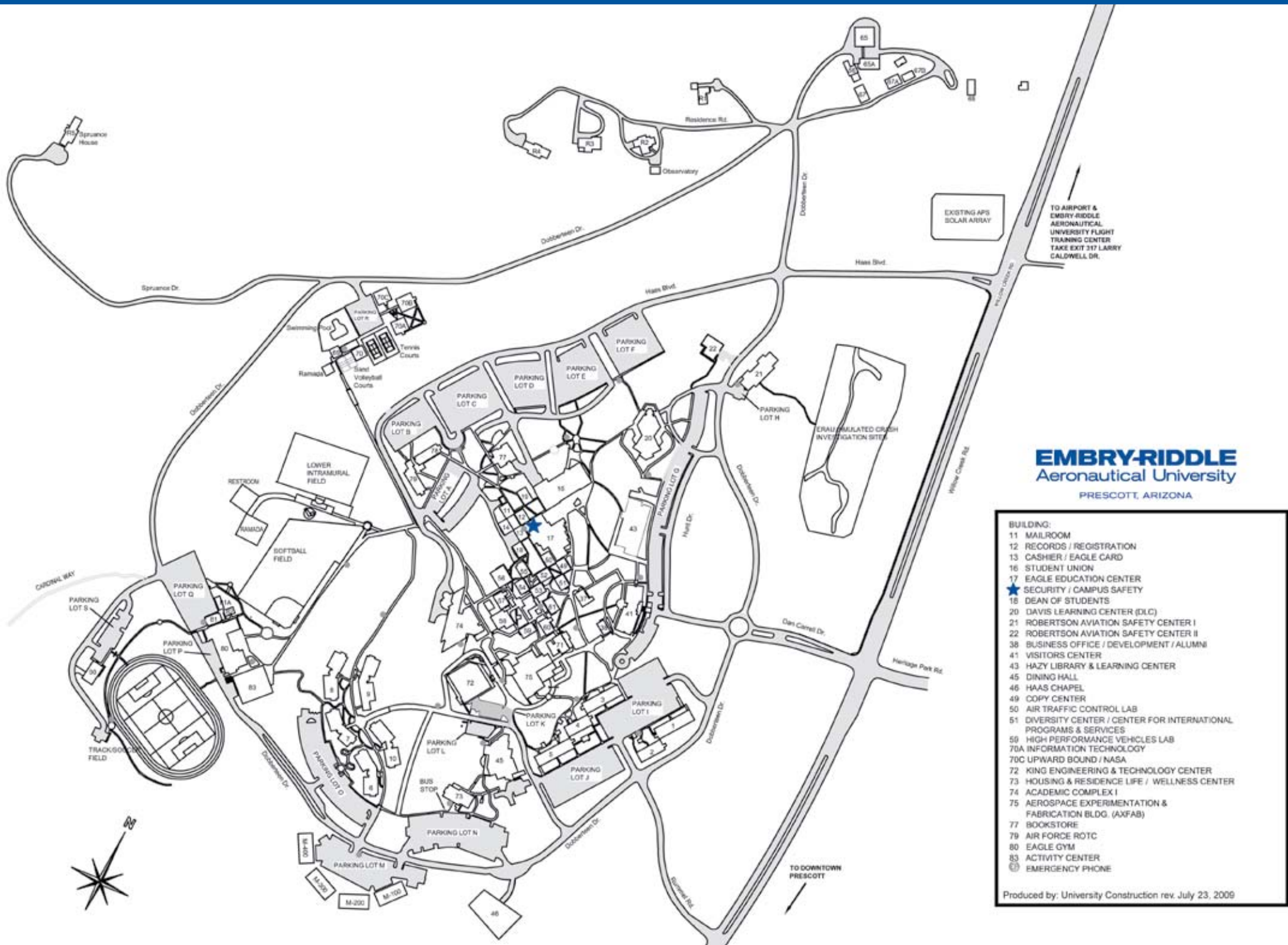

Wellness Center

Health Services

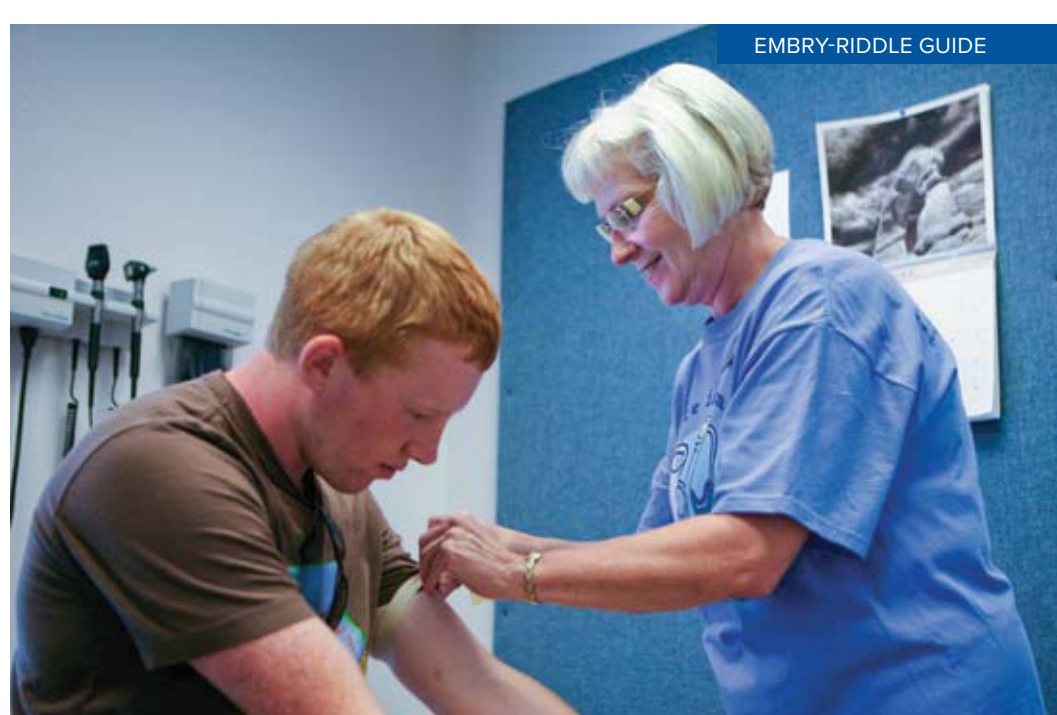
The Wellness Center provides comprehensive health care under the direction of a registered nurse to ensure all students' health concerns are met. Services provided include confirmation of required immunization status for incoming students, treatment of immediate health care issues, referrals to medical care providers in the community when necessary, first aid, CPR classes, dietary counseling and wellness education. We have three dentists on 24-hour emergency call and physicians on campus

four days a week – Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. A chiropractor is available three Tuesdays of every month and a massage therapist visits the campus every Wednesday afternoon. Hepatitis B, Pneumonia vaccine, MMRs, tetanus immunizations, and prescription drugs are available at a minimal cost to students. Flu shots are available in mid-October.

Student Health Insurance

Waivers open on July 1st for the following year. Deadlines vary each term and will be posted on the University website with a link to the waiver.

All students are required to have health insurance coverage and will be enrolled in the university student health insurance plan. Insurance premiums are charged automatically to student accounts. Students with comparable coverage must complete the online waiver form to remove the premium charge



from their account. You and your son/daughter are urged to carefully review the options and examine personal medical insurance plans before waiving the university plan. For more information, see the Student Health Insurance Policy located at www.uhcsr.com.

Disability Support Services

Frequently Asked Questions

What does the housing fee include?

All of our rooms are fully climate controlled and include all utilities, wireless high-speed internet access and cable television access. In addition, we provide each student with a bed and mattress (twin x-long mattress 36"x80"), closet space, dresser, desk, chair, and window coverings. Each living unit has a mini refrigerator, full size refrigerator or a ¾ refrigerator to be shared with others in the living space. The housing fee also includes access to staff 24 hours a day, seven days a week and special programming developed just for the students living on campus.

What is an Eagle Card?

The Eagle Card serves as student identification, an access key to residence halls, labs and meal plans, a campus debit card and library card. Eagle and flight dollars (accessible only for flight activities) can be deposited up to one month before orientation on student accounts at prescott.erau.edu/go/eagledeposit and following the link to "Make a guest deposit on your Eagle Card." Student first and last name, and student ID number are required to make deposits. ▶

Is the campus patrolled 24 hours?

Yes. The Safety Department patrols and services the campus 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

What if I want information concerning my student's records (grade reports, judicial actions) released?

FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) prevents any educational institution from releasing information without prior authorization from the student. Students who want information from their records released to parents or any other designee, must submit a signed Student Request to Share Information form to the Records Office or other Embry-Riddle staff member with a photo ID. If form is to be mailed or faxed, it must be notarized. This form may be obtained at the Records office.

Are cars allowed on campus?

Yes, students may choose to bring a car or motorcycle to campus and will be required to register their vehicle and obtain a parking permit from Campus Safety. Bicycles and skateboards are also popular choices for getting around, but are not allowed on the interior of campus for pedestrian safety on sidewalks.

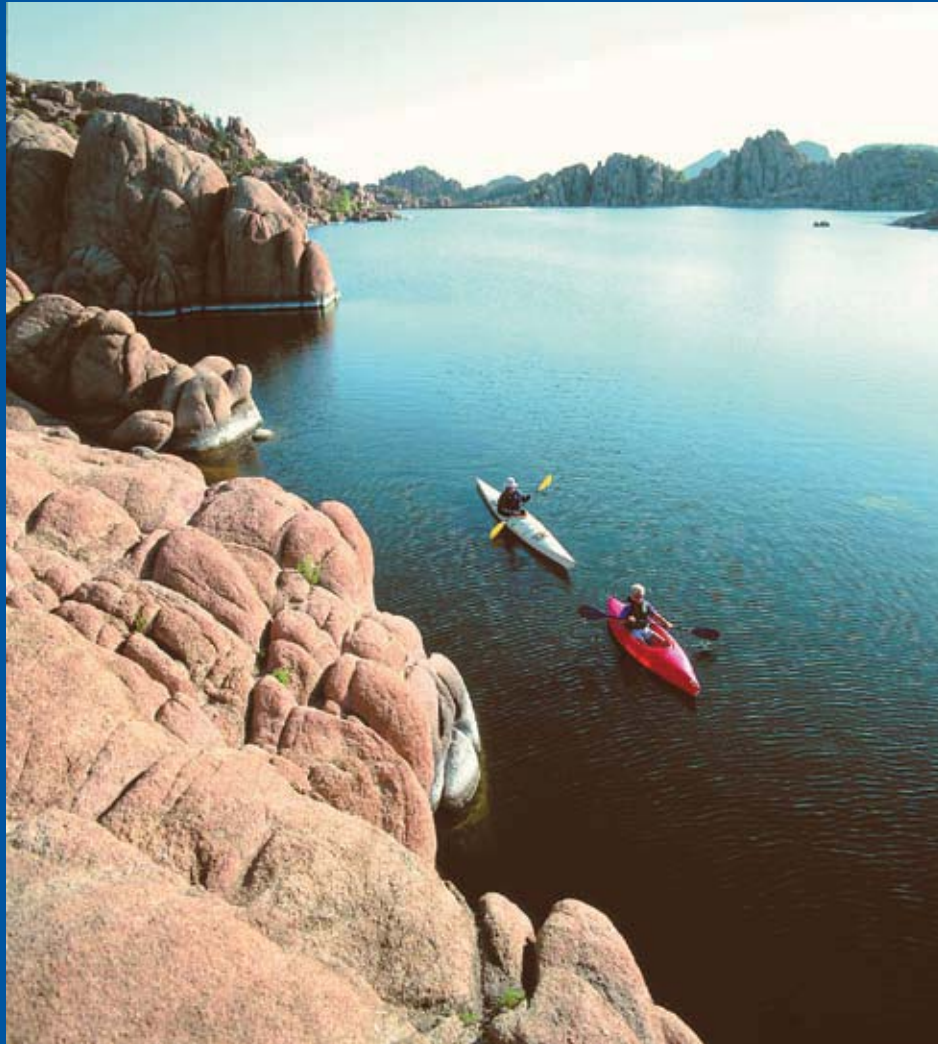
